Mille Miglia Racing Colours Racing in style

Rosso Corsa, Speed Silver, British Racing Green, Vintage Blue and Speed Yellow were the colours allocated to the various nations competing in the world of motor racing. To celebrate the 30th anniversary of the partnership between Chopard and Mille Miglia, the Maison is presenting a new collection composed of five Mille Miglia Racing Colours watches. A reedition of an historical Chopard collection featuring unique dials and intended for gentlemen drivers and collectors. These Mille Miglia Racing Colours are finely crafted 42 mm chronographs assembled by the Chopard master-watchmakers in 300-piece limited series for each dial colour. They pay tribute to the heyday of motorsports and to an exclusive race, the Mille Miglia, widely referred to as "la corsa la più bella del mondo".



The new Jaeger Le-Coultre Polaris collection channels the best of the Grande Maison's watchmaking tradition and its attention to detail, while creating a contemporary sporty yet elegant timepiece, with a vintage touch. The dial architecture in the Jaeger Le-Coultre Polaris collection is distinctive. combining a mixture of finishings on three concentric circles: a Memovox Polaris-inspired center with a sunray finish, graining on the outer circle with the hours and minutes, and an opaline finish on the rotating inner bezel. The Jaeger Le-Coultre logo is applied, as are the classic Arabic numbers and the contemporary trapezoidal indexes. The hands are large and filled with Super-LumiNova™ * for excellent visibility in low light. In two models, the Super-LumiNova™ * is vintage vanilla-colored as an homage to the look of Tritium featured on the original Memovox Polaris. They feature an eye-catching combination of brushed and hand-polished surfaces, with sharp, plunging lugs and thin, rounded bezels.

LAURENT FERRIFR I **Galet Minute Repeater School Piece**

Representing the ultimate horological complication, the Minute Repeater provides a wealth of inspiration, especially given the importance devoted to every detail of its construction. The case has been made of steel, a choice of material accentuating the chime and endowing it with a clear, light tone. So as to prolong the listening pleasure, the chime lasts is 17 seconds for the longest indications. Well-modulated spacing of the hours, quarters and minutes chimes is another key characteristic of this model. The Minute Repeater striking mechanism is activated by a sliding bolt built into the left side of the case-middle. Tiny hammers strike a two-pitched gong to sound the hours, quarters and minutes. Laurent Ferrier has treated the Minute Repeater dial with a 6N red gold color, featuring copper glints, thanks to the vertical satin-brushed finish that is a favorite with the Maison. The silver-toned small seconds subdial at 6 o'clock is adorned with a snailed finish
