

HUBLOT 'CATHEDRAL' MINUTE REPEATER TOURBILLON AND COLUMN WHEEL CHRONOGRAPH

This watch has three coveted complications, a minute repeater watch featuring two 'cathedral' type gongs, a tourbillon and column wheel chronograph, with carbon fibre bridges, in a case made from carbon fibre. The minute repeater, activated by means of a lever situated between 8 and 10 o'clock, sounds the hours, quarter-hours and minutes. It is integrated into the King Power case middle, just like the chronograph control push-piece is subtly integrated into the watch's crown.



LONGINES MASTER COLLECTION RETROGRADE MOON PHASES

This watch which comes in 41 mm and 44 mm cases features four retrograde hands which indicate day, night and phases of the moon. Apart from the regular functions it also features a 24-hour second time-zone on the left-hand side of the dial and a small seconds area at 6 o'clock.



MONT BLANC TOURBILLON MYSTERIEUSE

This 47 mm watch in a white gold case features a manual winding movement and a 1-minute tourbillon at 12 o'clock. The hour and minute hands are indicated on sapphire crystal disks.
